He had answered "Yes" to a history question and provided 31 documentation. The requirements for appropriate education and experience are stated in Rule 32 64B3-4.001, F.A.C., and Chapter 456.0635, F.S. 33 34 Ms. Norcia moved to approve Ms. Scott's application for licensure as a Clinical Laboratory 35 Trainee (Microbiology, Serology, Clinical Chemistry, Hematology, and 36 Immunohematology).
