42 (1) In order to renew a clinical laboratory personnel license, a minimum of 24 contact
43 hours of continuing education shall be earned during each biennium including a
44 minimum of one contact hour for each of the categories in which the individual is
45 licensed, and one contact hour of continuing education on HIV/AIDS. Also, as a part of

1 the 24 continuing education hours, each licensee shall take a Board approved 2-hour
2 course relating to the prevention of medical errors, which shall include root-cause
3 analysis, error reduction and prevention, and patient safety as related to the practice of
4 clinical laboratory personnel. Directors and supervisors are required to obtain one contact
5 hour of continuing education in administration and supervision. As part of the minimum
6 of 24 contact hours of continuing education, each licensee shall be required to take a one
7 hour course on Florida laws and rules governing clinical laboratory personnel or attend a
8 public meeting of the full Board at which disciplinary actions are addressed. A telephone
9 conference call meeting of the Board will not satisfy this requirement.
