Dr. Teofilo De Jesus Jimenez - Supervisor

Dr. Jimenez application was approved by Board staff.

### Janet S. Jones – Technician

Applicant employment verification was submitted from Florida Department of Health Bureau of Public Health reflecting experience from January 2014 to May 2014 in clinical chemistry. Department records show that Ms. Jones did not have a Florida license to work in the laboratory test environment. Ms. Jones doesn't meet the requirement under 64B3-5.004, F.A.C.

A formal compliant has been filed by the Board office for unlicensed activity.

## Allen B Mckay – Supervisor

Applicant was present and was not represented by counsel.

Ms. McKay has applied for Supervisor license in the specialty areas of Serology, Clinical Chemistry, and Hematology. Letters were submitted and Performance plan from Comprehensive Cancer Centers of Nevada, Riyadh Armed Forces Hospital verifying Ms. McKay employment dates only, and no test performed.

Applicant doesn't meet the experience requirements for licensure in Serology as listed in Rule 64B3-5.002, F.A.C.

Motion to require applicant to appear to the next board meeting and table application made by Mr. Shelfer second by Dr. Morgan.

Applicant indicated that to the Board members to issue license in clinical chemistry and hematology.

Motion to approve application in clinical chemistry and hematology only made by Van Siclen, second by Ms. Montoya.

Vote: 4 yeas / 0 opposed; motion carried

Motion was made to withdraw the motion to require appearing to next Board meeting made by Mr. Shelfer, second by Dr. Morgan.

#### Dr. Magdalena J. Orosz- Technologist

Applicant was present and was not represented by counsel.

Dr. Orosz has applied for licensure as a Clinical Laboratory Technologist in the area of Clinical Chemistry. Transcripts have been submitted from Rutgers the State University of New Jersey showing a Bachelor Degree in Biochemistry and Chemistry, and a Doctor of Philosophy in Chemistry from the University of Michigan. Employment verification and a letter were submitted from Access Medical Laboratories reflecting experience from November 2010 to May 2014 in Clinical Chemistry.

The applicants supporting documentation doesn't meet the requirements of Rule 64B3-5.003, F.A.C.

Motion to discuss in future board meeting once applicant files a petition/variance waiver made by Dr. Morgan, second by Ms. Van Siclen.
